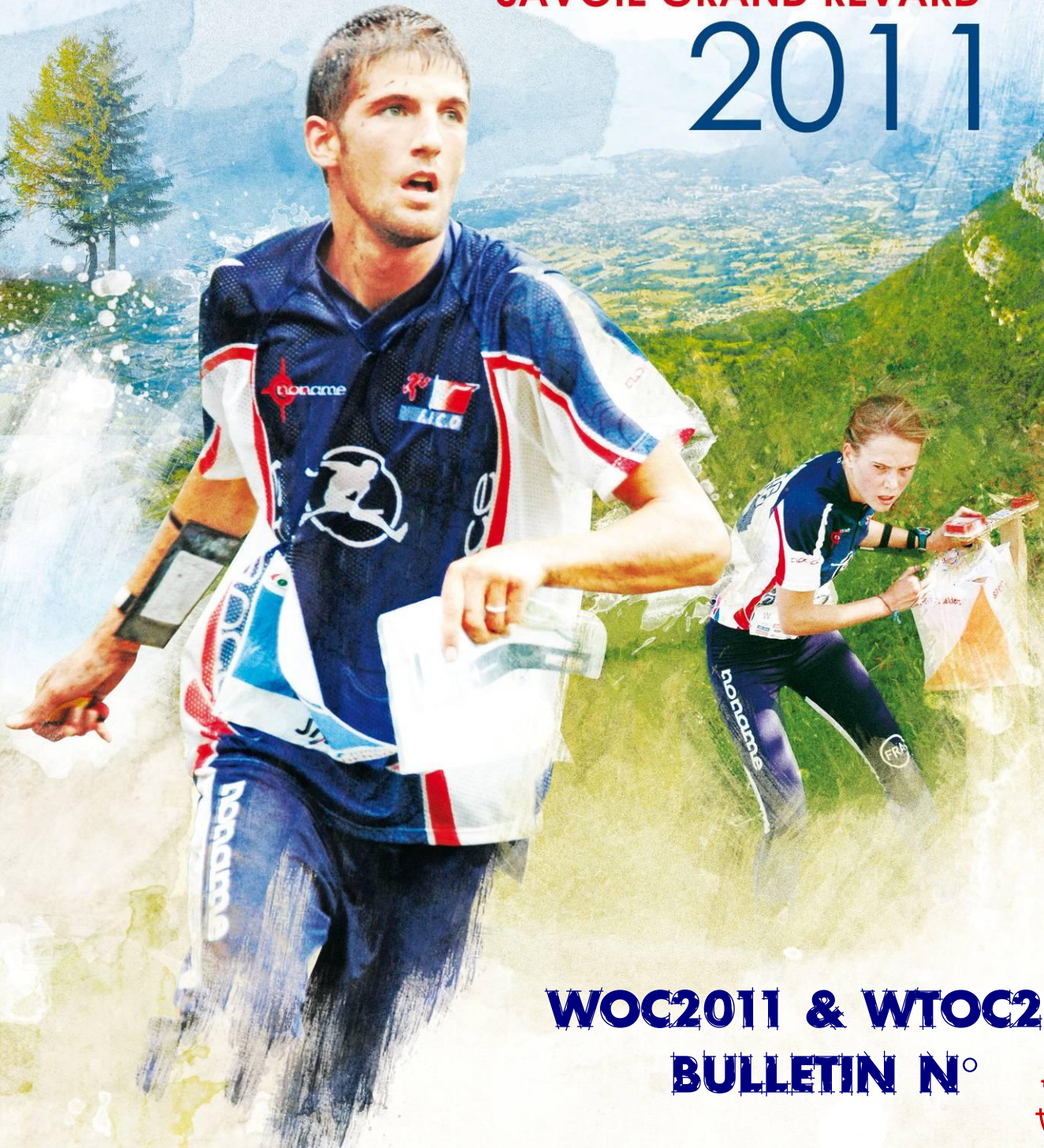

ACCESS & ACCREDITATION

ACCESS

Train: High speed trains (TGV) from Paris and many other connections.

Road: Motorways through Geneva, Lyon and Turin.

Air: The international airports of Lyon -St-Exupéry, Geneva and Grenoble are less than 60 minutes drive away. Coaches run from these airports to Chambéry. Lyon airport is also connected to Chambéry by a few trains daily.

ACCREDITATION

All entered participants are requested to check in on arrival for accreditation as follows:

- Team members for both WOC and WTOC: at the Event Centre in Aix-les-Bains
- Media representatives: at the Press Centre in the same building as the Event Centre
- IOF officials and Guests: at the Best Western Alexander Park Hotel in Chambéry

Each registered person must present his/her passport or identity card before he/she is accredited. A personal accreditation card with photo and an access code will be handed out at registration. All accredited persons must wear their WOC ID card at all relevant times for access to restricted zones.

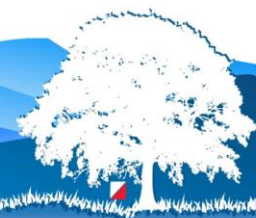

ANTI-DOPING

Doping is fundamentally contrary to the spirit of sport. The organisers of WOC2011 are committed to do all in their power to support the official anti-doping authorities in the successful and transparent realisation of their work.

The usual anti-doping tests decided by the IOF will be carried out at the competition venues. In addition, the French anti-doping agency (AFLD) may carry out spontaneous out of competition tests at their discretion.

The anti-doping test will be conducted in accordance with the procedures laid down in the WADA International Standards for Testing and the IOF anti-doping rules valid as from 1st February 2010.

COMPETITION RULES

The “**Competition Rules for Orienteering Events**” (version valid from 1st January 2011) shall be applied in all matters concerning WOC. With respect to previous World Championships this implies the following two important changes:

- The start interval in the long distance competitions will be 3 minutes (Rule 12.15).
- The winning times for the relay will be from 90 minutes to 105 minutes for both men and women (Rule 16.9) .

The “**Competition rules for Trail-Orienteeing Events**” (version valid from 1st February 2011) shall be applied in all matters concerning WTOC. With respect to previous World TrailO Championships this implies the following two important changes:

- The current Open and Paralympic World Champions may be entered by their Federations in their respective classes in addition to the normal maximum of three per class (Rule 6.5).
- For the team competition a team shall consist of three competitors with at least one competitor from the Open class and at least one competitor from the Paralympic class. Each Federation may nominate only one team (Rule 6.6).

10

TEAM OFFICIALS' MEETINGS

All the Team Officials' Meetings (TOMs) will be held at the Event Centre in Aix-les-Bains as indicated in the programme (chapter 7) for both WOC and WTOC.

Only accredited WOC and WTOC team members, IOF officials, invited guests and organisers will be admitted. At the TOMs the number bibs, start lists and further official information will be handed out.

CLOTHING

Ticks are endemic on the Revard plateau and competitors are advised to wear leg covering in all events except for the sprints. This includes WTOC competitors. There are no regulations concerning the type of footwear that may be worn.

PUNCHING AND TIMING SYSTEMS

12

The punching system used in all the WOC2011 competitions will be SPORTident. The SI cards will be provided. The SI cards will be given to team leaders when registering on arrival at the event centre and they will be asked to sign a receipt. Team leaders will have to return them at the Event Centre in one package per team before departure and there will be a 50€ charge for any missing cards. The cards will be attributed nominally to all WOC competitors and each card must be used exclusively by the competitor to whom it has been attributed. There will be spare cards at the start in the unlikely event of a last minute loss.

In addition to the SI card, competitors may have to carry a tracking device.

In individual competitions the start times will be determined as follows:

- **Qualification races:** listed start times - competitors will be released at the start by a hand on the shoulder
- **Finals:** start gates or photocells

In individual competitions the finish time will be measured by photocells across the finish line. The running times will be rounded down to the nearest second, except in the Sprint finals where they will be rounded down to the nearest tenth of a second.

The punching and timing equipment will be demonstrated at the technical model (12 August from 10:00 to 12:00 at the Model event) together with the organisation of the start.

NUMBER BIBS

13

During all the WOC and WTOC events competitors must wear number bibs (on the chest for WOC competitors). The bibs will be handed out at the respective Team Officials' Meetings, except for the sprint finals when they will be handed out to competitors as they enter the quarantine area. Bibs may not be folded to reduce their size.

For the prize-giving ceremonies, the prize-winners will be given special bibs which must be worn during the ceremony on the chest in place of the number bibs.

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

14

Teams may not train in Savoie outside the official training camps without the permission of the organising committee and signed by the Event Director.

During training sessions teams may put out their own controls but must label them with the name of the team and the date the control will be removed.

There will be open training possibilities on relevant maps in the WOC area every day from 10th to 18th August from 08:00 to 20:00. Model events will be organised on 11, 12, 15 and 18th August from 09:00 to 13:00 (see Programme for details).

Costs

- Clean offset-printed or laser-printed maps, per copy: 4 €
- Rental of an SI card for an entire training camp: 15 €
- Map files in JPEG or GIF format, per map: 80 €
- OCAD map files, per map: 120 € (subject to signing an agreement on usage)
- Training sessions on a network of controls, per session per map: 6 €
- Training courses with SPORTident punching system, per course per map: 8 €

EMBARGOED AREAS

With reference to the IOF Competition Rules (article 26.6):

The Savoie Grand Revard resort

The embargoed part of the resort is shown on the map on page 11. All potential WOC2011 team members, team officials or any other person who could influence the results of the competitions by knowledge of the terrain, are not allowed to enter the embargoed area. However, paved public roads passing through the area may be used. Certain parts of the embargoed area have been progressively released as they were used during the training camps, but they remain out of bounds for accommodation. The following villages are also within this embargoed area:

- St François de Sales: La Magne, Charmillon, Le Champ
- Montagny

The embargo is for both WOC and WTOC teams, but WTOC teams may have their accommodation in the embargoed area during the WTOC.

Chambéry and Aix-les-Bains

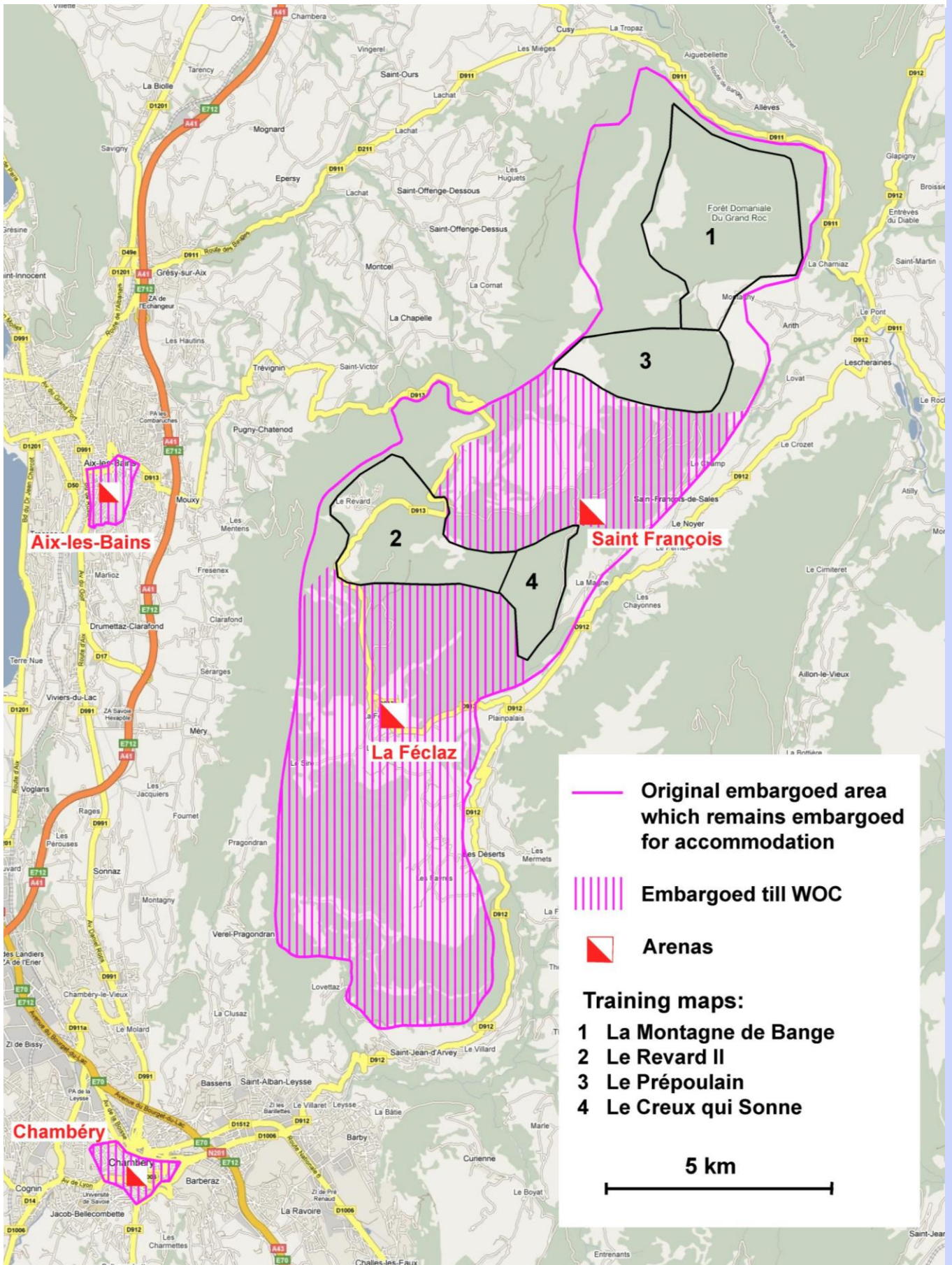
1. Anyone may reside, visit, shop or work in these cities but orienteering is permitted only on the following maps:
Sur les Monts; Petit Port d'Aix; Forêt de Corsuet
2. In the embargoed areas shown in detail in the chapter "Competition Areas" (page 13) it is forbidden to:
 - orienteer
 - test route choices
 - survey or make any use of maps
 - enter wooded areas, parks and backyards
 - to video record or to photograph
3. On Tuesday 16th August, all teams staying in hotels within the embargoed area of Aix-les-Bains will have to leave the area by 7am. All competitors and team officials will have to check-in at the quarantine by latest 9 am.
4. From 12th August till the end of the Sprint final on 16th August the embargoed area in Chambéry is completely closed to all team members except on 15th August for the sprint model where team members must remain in the area covered by the model map.

General map of the region showing the embargoed areas



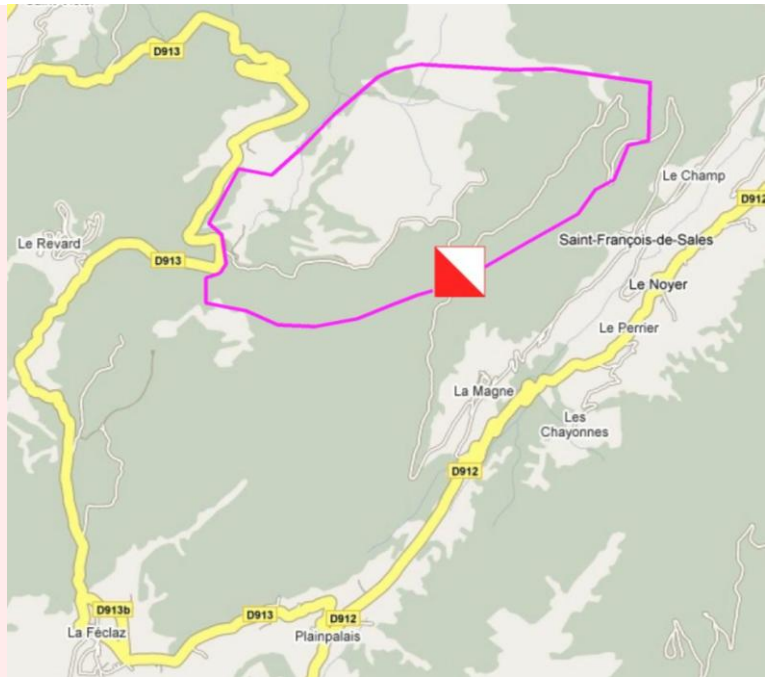

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION

– *Sprint qualifications and Finals*

Terrain: Urban with small wooded areas and parks. There are some steep hills.
Runnability: Very good

– *Middle and Long Distance qualifications and finals*

– *Relay*

(the same terrain is used for the WTOC competitions)

Terrain: The Savoie Grand Revard is a karst plateau situated between 1200 m and 1500 m in altitude. It has significant but reasonable variations in its relief. There are alpine meadows and areas of semi-open forest. The vegetation alternates between coniferous and deciduous trees. The chaotic surface (rocks, sinkholes, karren) provides exceptionally varied competition terrain.

Runnability: Good in the meadows and the semi-open forest but can be poor in the many rocky or steep areas.

Visibility: Generally quite good but can be very limited in areas of dense vegetation.

Roads, paths and tracks: The network of paths, tracks and roads is not very dense.

All Orienteers are welcome to participate in the **O'Festival ERDF Savoie Grand Revard**, a 6-day open public event for all age classes. All the competition terrains will have been used for the WOC, either for competitions or training.

Particular conditions for WOC team members

- Subject to the availability of vacant places, competitors who have failed to qualify for the Middle or Long distance finals may participate free of charge in the O'Festival ERDF Savoie Grand Revard stage on the day of the respective finals. Entries will have to be registered at the Event Centre during the evening immediately following each qualification race.
- WOC team officials may participate in the O'Festival ERDF Savoie Grand Revard free of charge but must enter via internet before 5th August (see website) indicating they are team officials. They may also enter on the day of the event, but then they will only have access to the wayfarer courses which are not timed.
- All other team members may take part in O'Festival ERDF Savoie Grand Revard races under the same conditions as any member of the general public. For details please see the WOC website.

MEALS & REFRESHMENTS IN THE ARENAS

Team members and spectators will be able to have their meals in the arenas of the Savoie Grand Revard plateau in the public catering tent.

The currency for buying meals and refreshments will be the **WOC**. The value of a **WOC** will be 1 € and these will be on sale near the public catering tent and at other locations in the spectator area.

IOF, DELEGATES and GUESTS

IOF, delegates and their guests are offered accommodation in two neighbouring (100m) hotels in Chambéry: The Best Western Alexander Park*** (address: 51 rue Alexander Fleming) and Ibis** (address: 100 rue Eugène Ducretet). All IOF meetings will be held at the Alexander Park.

There will be a permanent WOC desk at the Alexander Park manned from 10th to 20th August from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 18:00 to 20:00. All those having "IOF and Guest" accreditations will be able to withdraw their badges and information material at this desk.

The VIP / IOF / Media race will take place at Le Revard on Thursday 18th August from 16:00 to 18:00. Entries should be made at the Alexander Park WOC desk or at the Event Centre.

The IOF's 50th Anniversary will be celebrated throughout the Championships but in particular in the arena of the Middle Distance Finals just before the start of the event.

The official Media Centre will be at the **Centre des Congrès** in Aix-les-Bains, at the same location as the Event Centre (see page 13 for map). High standard facilities are provided including high capacity internet connections.

During the **WOC individual finals and the Relay** the media centre will be relocated in the arenas in a marquee tent with all the required facilities. Press conferences will be held there after each of the final events. After sprint final the press conference will be held in a nearby hall.

For the qualification races the following facilities will be available:

- **Sprint:** no additional facilities as the arena is within easy reach of the Media Centre.
- **Middle and Long Distance:** a press room will be available but there will be no internet connections and the mobile phone coverage is poor.

In the Finals and Relay arenas there will be photo zones for accredited photographers. There will also be a photo zone close to a control point to which photographers will be accompanied in limited numbers.

The VIP / IOF / Media race will take place at Le Revard on Thursday 18th August from 16:00 to 18:00. Entries should be made at the Media Centre.

TRAIL ORIENTEERING "WORLD TEMPO TROPHY"

TempO is a new format of Trail orienteering where the speed of decision making is an essential element as it consists only of timed controls.

The World TempO Trophy event will be held on Thursday 18th August at La Féclaz François. There will be two classes, one for WTOC teams and one for the general public.. The event is open to all for an entry fee of 10 €. Entries will be taken on the spot only. Detailed information on the times will be given on the website and in Bulletin n°4.

TRANSPORT

The WOC2011 organisers recommend that public transport be used whenever it is available or provided.

Transportation from and to the airports of Lyon, Geneva or Grenoble can be arranged on request.

For teams a transport package is offered at a cost of 100 € per person for WOC and 50 € per person for WTOC. This includes transport from Aix-les-Bains or Chambéry:

- from and to the railway or airport coach station in those cities
- to and from the model events
- to and from the competition arenas

This transportation should have been reserved via the entry form.

Apart from the above, there will be no organised transportation to the events. Teams not requesting transportation are expected to arrange their own transport at their own expense and risk. On registration at the Event Centre teams will be given parking cards. Only vehicles with WOC parking cards will be permitted to park in the restricted parking zones near the arenas.

For IOF Officials and Guests and Media Representatives transport is offered from the recommended hotels in Chambéry or from the Centre des Congrès in Aix-les-Bains to and from the finals arenas of the Long Distance, the Middle Distance and the Relay at a total cost of 50 €. This transportation should have been reserved via the entry form.

LOCAL WEATHER AND CLIMATE

The weather in Savoie in August is normally warm and pleasant. There is occasionally a tendency for thunderstorms in the evenings. To give an idea of what the weather could be, the table below gives the values measured in Chambéry at the same dates in 2008.

On the Savoie Grand Revard plateau the temperatures are on the average 3° lower than in Chambéry, but the difference varies generally from 0° to 5°.

According to current regulations, citizens of the following IOF member countries do not need visas in order to enter France:

Argentina, Australia, Austria, Barbados, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hong-Kong, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea (South), Latvia, Lichtenstein, Lithuania, Macedonia, Malaysia, Montenegro, Norway, Netherlands, New-Zealand, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Rumania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Uruguay, USA, Venezuela.

Team members from these countries need only have a passport valid until at least 3 months after their return to their own country, for a stay not exceeding 3 months.

Teams from countries needing visas must have:

- a document accepted by the French authorities justifying their stay in France (e.g. invitation, accommodation reservations, airline tickets),
- a passport valid until at least 3 months after their return to their own country,
- a visa which must be applied for at the nearest consulate or embassy consular service before departure.
- The WOC organising committee will request the Ministry in charge of immigration to exempt delegations from paying for tourist visas. For this purpose each country concerned must send the list of the members of its team to the organising committee **by latest 27th June 2011** giving names, first names and passport numbers.

Please note that conditions of entry can change and all WOC participants are advised to be kept informed of any changes — see the website: www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/

FINAL ENTRIES FOR TEAMS

Final entries for teams (including for each team member the full name, gender and date of birth, **together with an identity photo**) must be fed into the on-line entry form on the WOC website by 1st August 2011 at the very latest, for both WOC and WTOC teams.

The form is on-line as from 25th June 2011 (www.woc2011.fr).

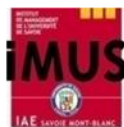
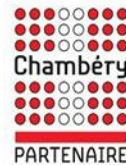


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
